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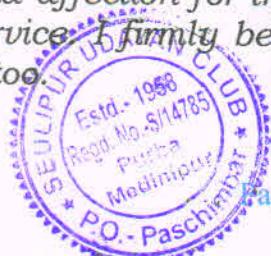

-: INITIATIVE OF SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB :-

Again is a problem today, the world over, in India, the population of aged people (60 plus) ,as per 1991 census was 56,7 million which was 6.76% of total population .This shows doubling of the aged population as compared to 1961 census when it was only 25.6 million, thanks to the invention of life savings drugs and general health conciseness of the people,

An Expert committee headed by the Register General and census commissioner of India has made a population projection for the next few years till 2016,According to the projection , the population of aged people in India will substantially grow from 56 million in 1991 to 71 million in 2001, 96 million 2011 and further to 113 million by 2016.His shows that the growth rate of elderly people will accelerate from 3,13% in 1989- 1991 to 3,45% during 2001-2017, this will substantially increase the share of aged people (60 Plus) in the overall population from 6.76% in 1991 to 8.94% in 2016.

As in case of general population the sex ratio is quite adverse to the case of age segment too. However, the male predominance is limited to the lower age growth generally and to the rural areas only .In the higher age group of 70 plus category the number of female was 1024 females as against 1000 males .However, in the lower age group of 60-70 , the number of females was 959 against 1000 males in consonance with the general trend of population.

In accordance with the general pattern of India Population division between urban and rural, about 66.9% of aged population live in rural areas. Almost three fourths (73%) of the 60 plus population in India was illiterate in 1991.he position of aged women was much worse than that of men with regard to Literacy and education.

Against the back drop, the authorities of SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB had observed, with great dismay, that most of the aged people in India are leading a very precarious life due mainly to (1) absence of any full-proof social security safety net for the aged people (2) gradual break done of joint family system and (3) absence of gainful employment opportunities for the aged, particularly in rural areas.

SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB had therefore, extended their helping hands to these helpless aged people living in rural areas to make their last lap of life a little more comfortable.

MAIN PROGRAMMES ARE RUNNING UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE ORGANIZATION.

❖ **SENIOR CITIZENS HOME (OLD AGE HOME) – SEULIPUR UNIT-PURBA MEDINIPUR DISTRICT:** SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB had established an old age home since 1993-94 with the financial assistance from Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. In this home 25 Aged men and Women are being maintained over the years and are being provided with free boarding, lodging, medical treatment and recreational facilities etc. This is an ongoing programme in which new people are enrolled in case there is a vacancy on account of death or otherwise of the aged people which is the most inevitable fact of life for every human being.





❖ **SENIOR CITIZENS HOME (OLD AGE HOME) – JHARGRAM UNIT-**

JHARGRAM DISTRICT: For those aged people above 60 years of age, who have shelter but feel quite lonely during day time, as their relations, SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB had established One Day care Centers, since 1993 at present One unit Totanala Day Care Centres Converted to Senior Citizens Homes for 25 destitute Senior Citizens transferred to Jhargram District at Bhairabkundu (Landmark- Shib Mandir) Vill.- Bhairabkundu, P.O.-Dharampur, P.S.-Lalgarh, Block- Binpur-I, Dist.- Jhargram, W.B., Pin- 721516. In such Homes 25 nos men & women are being maintained since April 2018 are are being provided with free boarding, lodging, medical treatment and recreational facilities etc.

This is an ongoing programme in which new people are enrolled in case there is a vacancy on account of death or otherwise of the aged people which is the most inevitable fact of life for every human being .Assistance for the purpose has been provided by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment Government of India.





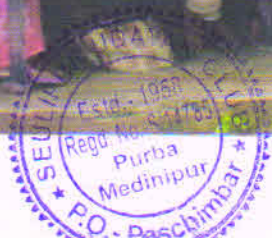
❖ **SENIOR CITIZENS HOME (OLD AGE HOME) – BIRBHUM UNIT- BIRBHUM DISTRICT:** For those aged people above 60 years of age, who have shelter but feel quite lonely during day time, as their relations, SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB had established another one Day care Centers, since 1993 at present One unit Seulipur Day Care center Converted to Senior Citizens Homes for 25 destitute Senior Citizens transfer to Birbhum District at Chandipur (Landmark-Tarapith Mandir) Vill.- Chandipur, P.O.- Chandipur, Block- Rampurhat-II, Dist.- Birbhum, W.B., Pin- 731233 In such Homes 25 nos men & women are being maintained since April 2018 are being provided with free boarding, lodging, medical treatment and recreational facilities etc.





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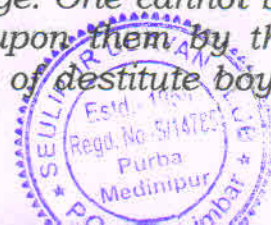
❖ **MOBILE MEDICARE UNIT (M.M.U.):** SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB had also established a Mobile Medicare Unit for the aged people ,thanks to the authorities of the ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government India for the purpose. This unit had started functioning from the year 1994-95.Under this scheme, one duly qualified medical officer (B.H.M.S.) and one helper have been appointed and a car has been taken on hire. the physical and his helper moves out from village to village for premises on account of their age, ailments as well as bad road conditions. As per the programme, at least 10 camps are held in a month on per fixed dates and time in particular villages on that people can take advantage of free consultation and free medicines for their treatment. For the purpose apart from the running cost of vehicle and the salary of the Medical Officer and the helper. The ministry of Social Justices & Empowerment, Government of India is providing Rs. 18.75 as cost of curative medicines per head per month. Although, the amount is too small, more particularly in view of the rising cost of medicines, yet this becomes a great help for poor people as they able to get the much needed medical attention at their door steps.





❖ **PHYSIOTHERAPY CLINIC FOR SENIOR CITIZENS:** We are successfully going on a physiotherapy and Yogotherapy camp in our Organization from 01.04.2019. Many people from different Villages interested in this Camps because previously they are suffering from various diseases such as arthritis, rheumatism, abdominal disorder, respiratory complaint but now they are free from their complaints for active participation in our physiotherapy and yogotherapy camp. So we are very much interested in running a healthcare system method in our locality. Physiotherapy is a dynamic profession, which uses a range of treatment techniques to restore movement and function within the body. Physiotherapy is the assessment and treatment of physical health and aims to correct disorders of the musculo-skeletal system. The purpose of treatment is to restore normal levels of activity and balance within the muscular-skeletal system using rehabilitation rather than medicine. Physiotherapy also known as physical therapy is a health care profession, which views human movement as central to the health and well-being of individuals. Physiotherapy is a health care profession which assists people to restore, maintain and maximize their strength, function, movement and overall well-being. Physiotherapy includes rehabilitation as well as prevention of injury and promotion of health and fitness. The treatment of disease, injury or deformity by physical methods such as massage, heat treatment and exercise rather than by drugs or surgery. Physiotherapists and physical therapists work within a wide variety of health settings to improve a broad range of physical problems associated with different systems of the body. In particular, they treat the neuromuscular, musculo-skeletal, cardio-vascular and respiratory systems. Physiotherapy is a holistic approach to healthcare and plays a vital part in pain relief, healing and rehabilitation in most medical and surgical conditions.

❖ **COTTAGE HOME (DESTITUTE HOME):** The best investment of any country is the investment in health and education of children so that we may create a build of future citizens who will be physically fit and mentally alert. This highly commercialized world today is not only unfair to the fair of sex but also tries to squeeze out unfair advantages from the under-age. One cannot be a silent spectator without protest against such unfair atrocities upon them by the grown-up people. However, this generally happens more the case of destitute boys who have no kith and kin to support them financially.





With assistance from the Directorate of Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal, Seulipur Udayan club had established a destitute home since 1994-95 with capacity of 125 boys at present capacity of the Home 125 boys, he homes provides these boys with free boarding, lodging and garments and also impart general education and vocational training to these boys so that they can become proud citizens of India in course of time and can prove themselves as assets to the society and not liabilities.



❖ **HOSTAL FOR BOYS (SECENDARY):** SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB believes that the education is essential to ensure a better quality of life for all student and a better environment for all student. Our organization has been able to open a



Secendary Hostel for Boys SC,ST,OBC & General in regard to the education of their student. The free Secendary Boys Hostel for Boys has been adopted in the year 2019 till today are running. Presently there are Secendary classes from Nine & Ten Clases in this Hostel with the student strength of near about 50 coming from SC,ST,OBC and General families study materials,Test Books and school dresses are provided free of cost etc. No Government Grant till today. The Hostel is completely running on private aid. The Hostel staff has been engaged here on a honorarium basis.

❖ **CHILDREN LIBRARY:** Even when the students go to schools, they hardly get support for their learning as their parents are more often not able to give them adequate support for the purpose of necessary books, etc.with a view to ameliorate this problem to some extent, Seulipur Udayan club with financial assistance from National children's fund, Government of W.B. had been able to established a children's library for the benefit of children of the age group of 05-16 Years. i.e just after living the crèche and going for education in normal schools, his library is now providing full support for knowledge to about 125 children of the Home. It might be worth mentioning here that in addition to the support for general education to these students, it has also been provided in the scheme to integrate health care services and a nutritious day meal to the day scholars who visit the library regularly.

❖ **I.C.D.S. PROJECT- KHARAGPUR-II BLOCK- PASCHIM MEDINIPUR:** SEULIPUR UDAYAN CLUB had also established a recently new one above scheme organize by our society at Kharghapur - 2 block, Paschim Medinipur, West Bengal. The main object of the scheme - to improve nutritional and health status of children in the age group of 0-6 yrs, to lay foundation of proper psychological, physical and social development of children to reduce the incidence of mortality, morbidity, malnutrition and school dropout, to enhance the capability of the mother to look after the normal health and nutritional need of the child through proper nutrition and health education.





Packages : Supplementary nutrition / Immunization / Health Check – up / Referral services / Nutrition and Health Education / Non-formal Education. Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme, to provide to children from the deprived sections of the society, the basic services for a better start in life. The Scheme provides services in an integrated manner to children below the age of 6 years.





The major objectives of the ICDS Scheme are :

i) Improvement in nutritional and health status of the children in the age group of 0-6 years; ii) Laying the foundation for a proper psychological, physical and social development of the children; iii) Reduction in the incidence of mortality, morbidity, malnutrition and school dropouts; iv) Co-ordination of policy and implementation amongst various departments to promote child development v) Enhancement of the capacity of the mother to look after the normal health and nutritional needs of the child through proper nutrition and health education.

OTHER ACTIVITIES OF THE ORGANIZATION

- ❖ **AWARENESS CAMP:** Here was a time in the west Bengal when the common people were confounded as they were decided in their daily life and did not have the least knowledge as to how to combat those unfair businessman, traders, lawyers, doctors and other professionals and service providers, who have very much united in their interest of deceitful gains. Just at this juncture, some consumer activities were generated and decided to work under one umbrella with the object to unite the common interest and this the organization has taken the definite steps for the general awareness with workshop, leaflets, mike meeting, Banner/holdings in the locality.
- ❖ **FOOD RELIEF DISTRIBUTION & CLOTHE DISTRUBITION:** In every year flood effected due to damp breacking of Kaliagai River, denjours river of Purba & Paschim medinipur District. In this year seriously area effected by flood. We collect some materials from Help Age India and distributed among the people of the area.



❖ **AIDS CAMP:** The most remarkable of the outgoing century which has even established as the serious crisis of the human beings in AIDS and the entire medical world is now under the so called struggles to irradiate it and even to keep forest zone from the civilization through the general awareness with active participation as R.P. of reputed doctors with different Audi visual media vastly. The organization with its limited and insufficient funds has baled to cover the area.

❖ **CHARITABLE DISPENSARY:** A charitable dispensary is running under the supervision of the organization. One B.H.M.S. Doctor attends the dispensary two times in a week. Homeopath medicine gives to the beneficiaries free of cost. Poor people of the locality benefited in the scheme.

❖ **SPORTS GAMES AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES:** Like previous year we have arranged sports for the school students, with different items like run, long jump, high jump, photo race, musical chair and other attractive event. It has divided two parts one for boys and another for girls 'Go as you like' events for all.

Some sources of joy change the mind of a man help to forget his sorrow. The culture programme should be done in the Village level .It is quite open to all that village people belonging to education backward class cannot perform cultural programme by themselves and to implement any cultural activity a voluntary organization only can be co-ordination in this respect. This year we arranged Annual Sports. Different cultural functions along with sports activities have been performed by villagers and rural youths People from different walks of life participated and enjoyed this festival.

In the evening cultural function has organized .any students and people of the locality has participated at it. We have arranged national film, Baul Gan, Pali Sangit and organizes drama with the active help of members of the organization.

-: CONCLUSION :-

It is evident from the above statement that a variety of programmers a mixed result noticed, some programmers completed its target but performance of some others did not satisfactory, but we are still hopeful and expect bright future activities.
